Judy Blume is not your average bestselling author. Since the publication of *Are You There God? It's Me, Margaret* in 1970, Judy has written about subjects that many considered taboo. Her kids books were often among the most challenged books of the year. She has also been a leader in the fight against book censorship, joining booksellers, teachers, librarians, parents and students who are defending the realistic depictions of life that kids need as they struggle to become adults.

It is because Judy Blume is both a truth-teller and a defender of the kids' right to read that the American Booksellers for Free Expression (ABFE), the ABC Children's Group at the American Booksellers Association and Random House Children's Books will honor her during the 21st Annual Silent Auction at BookExpo America on Tuesday, May 26.
