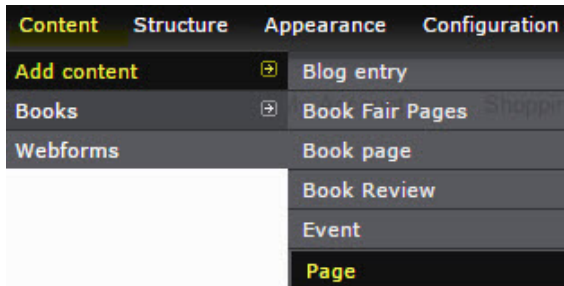


Creating pages is one of the first steps to setting up your website and something you will do frequently. The steps below give you all the options available when doing so. The only required options are those noted with a red asterisk *


