

Automatic Coupons are a convenient way to provide a discount for a group of people within a certain role without having to give out multiple coupon codes or requiring the user to enter a code each time. For the example below we are creating a 'Automatic Coupon' for people with the role of 'Staff Member'.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Setting up a role requires ABA to create a unique role under your account for that group of users. If you have not done so already please send an email requesting a new role be created for your website. ABA will confirm when the role has been created. Ex.: Please create a new role of 'Staff Member' for my website. We will be creating a special discount coupon for those customers.







ASSIGNING A USER A ROLE

If this is a user who previously signed up, ask them for the email address associated with their account. If the user has never signed up, ask them to first sign up and provide you with the email address they use. You must know the email address associated with the user account in order to proceed with the steps below and successfully assign the user a role.

At this point you have assigned them the role, if they were previously logged in while you were assigning them a role they should log out and log back in to gain any special permissions their new role provides (in this example a 20% discount applied to their subtotal).
