The Absolute Value of Mike, by Kathryn Erskine (Philomel, \$16.99) "This is a lovely tale of resilience and discovery. Mike is sent to stay with his great-uncle and uncle while his professor father goes to teach in Romania for the summer. Mike shortly finds himself the leader of a whirlwind campaign to help the local minister adopt a boy who seems hauntingly similar to himself, although he was orphaned on the other side of the world.
