Noah Barleywater Runs Away, by John Boyne, Oliver Jeffers (illus.) (David Fickling Books, \$16.99) "Noah, age eight, runs away from a difficult reality at home to a fantasyland where trees scold him and animals talk. He finds a toy shop in which all the toys are made of wood, including row upon row of puppets. The old and engaging shop owner tells his own story, and through gentle, savvy and wise dialogue leads Noah to return home.
