The Adjustment: A Novel, by Scott Phillips (Counterpoint, \$14.95) "Wayne Ogden has returned home from WWII and works as a caretaker and procurer for his debauched boss, while itching for the same action he had as a shady supply sergeant. It doesn't take long before he gets involved in blackmail, pornography, and murder even as he receives a bunch of mysterious letters from someone aware of his criminal past. Playing fast and loose with the dark side of the 'Greatest Generation,' Scott Phillips once again creates a tight, funny noir that's rich in character, and makes the profane sacred." —**Scott Montgomery, BookPeople, Austin, TX**
