The Return of Captain John Emmett: A Mystery, by Elizabeth Speller (Mariner, \$14.95) "It is in particular stories of war that we are forced to see how one life lost effects so many others. Speller's novel of the aftermath of World War I is such a story. After his military service has ended, John Emmett is found dead, an apparent suicide. His grieving sister Mary calls on an old schoolmate, to help her understand what has happened. It is revealed that others involved with Emmett in a disturbing wartime event have also died violently.
