

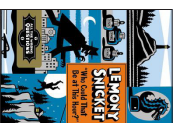

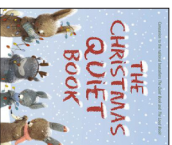
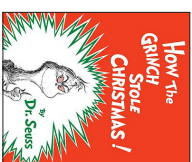

by Barry Deutsch (Amulet, \$16.95)

Once again, Mirka is dodging chores (especially knitting—she HATES knitting), trying—and failing—to beat her wiley stepmother at chess, and seeking mischief and mayhem whenever possible, but this time with the help of a Mirka look-alike named Metty.
