
Lighthouse Island: A Novel, by Paulette Jiles (William Morrow, \$26.99) "A century and a half into a worldwide drought finds Earth to be a bleak, dry, decaying urban landscape, precarious for everyone but especially for Parentless Dependent Children like Nadia.
