



Only Love Can Break Your Heart: A Novel, by Ed Tarkington (Algonquin Books, \$15.95)

"Tarkington's debut novel feels positively Shakespearean in its sense of family dynamics and the sometimes destructive power of love, but it speaks with the deceptively plain, poignant language of a Neil Young song. Set in the 1980s in a small Virginia town, it tells the coming-of-age story of Rocky Askew as he copes with fraternal abandonment, dangerous liaisons, caregiving, and one scandal after another with little help other than his brother Paul's old vinyl collection.
