Tip: Run a campaign for customers to purchase an extra book for your store to donate to a local children's organization.

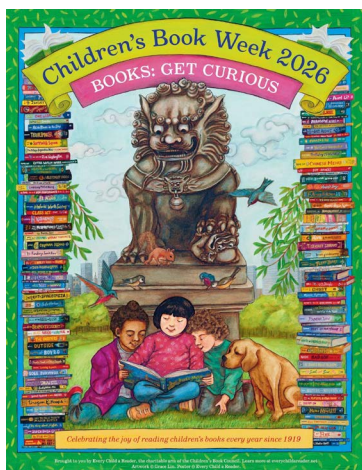
